<p>Day 7</p>	<p><u>One day tour</u> Dr. Sun Yat-sen's Mausoleum is located on the southern slope of the Purple Mountain in the eastern suburb of the city. The construction of the mausoleum was started in 1926, just on the occasion of the first anniversary of Dr. Sun's death, and was completed in the spring of 1929. The Grand Funeral was held on June 01, 1929.</p>  <p>The Ming Tomb is the tomb of Zhu YuanZhang, the first emperor of the Ming Dynasty with the history of more than 600 years. It lies at the southern foot of the Purple Mountain. The tomb complex is one of the largest ancient mausoleums of the emperors in China.</p> 	

	<p>Linggu Park lies about one and half kilometers east of Dr Sun Yat-sen’s Mausoleum. It is the only one out of 70 Buddhist monasteries handed down from the Southern Dynasties. This temple was first been built in 515 AD by Princess Yong Ding of Liang Dynasty (502-557 AD) for the famous Monk Bao Zhi .</p> 	
<p>Day 8</p>	<p>Visit Lantern Maker---Mr Lu’s factory And learn how to hand make traditional Chinese Lantern</p>  <p>The Confucius Temple The Confucius Temple is located on the busiest street in the entire southern part of Nanjing city. The Temple is over a thousand years old and was originally a place set aside to revere Confucius by offering sacrifices to his memory. As a national cultural relic protection unit, Zhanyuan is located at South Zhanyuan Road and faces south. So far, it has had a history of more than 600 years, and is the only one that has well-kept classical garden buildings redolent of the Ming Dynasty.</p>
